#### Agenda 1 & 2: Welcome and Introductory Remarks

- The General Secretary (GS), Dr Anuradha Agrawal, welcomed all the members of the EC and expressed her gratitude for their presence in the meeting. She informed that Dr Dinesh Kumar, Treasurer, and Dr P.W. Ramteke, Councillor (CZ) who had confirmed their participation in the EC meeting, were held up at the last moment and could not attend the meeting.
- Dr R.S. Paroda, President, also welcomed all the members and thanked them for their presence. He observed that the EC was meeting after a gap of more than six months, and efforts be made to hold the meeting once in 3-4 months to keep the momentum of work. He informed that during his recent visit to USA, he met Dr Kamal Bawa, a distinguished Professor of Biology at Department of Biology, University of Massachusetts, Boston, USA. Dr Bawa has consented to give the 2<sup>nd</sup> Dr D.S. Athwal Memorial Lecture during his visit to India in Jan 2020. Necessary follow-up action to be taken by Dr Kuldeep Singh, Director, NBPGR.

#### Agenda 3: Confirmation of the Minutes of last EC Meeting and Action Taken Report

• The General Secretary proposed that salary of the ISPGR staff (one full time and one part time Assistants) by increased w.e.f. October 2019. The increments given in the past are as follows:


