Amendment of ISPGR Rules for holding Elections via e-ballot

(as per discussion in 11th EC meeting held on Aug. 24, 2021)

- Due to COVID19 pandemic, there is general disruption in postal services. Also advances in digital technology has provided options for electronic voting, which has also been adopted by other scientific societies.
- Use of e-ballots to conduct ISPGR elections shall also reduce the time and financial resources.
- Proposal was unanimously agreed by the EC in its 11th meeting and it was advised to
 place the same for approval in the GBM. The e-voting option so agreed be revisited
 by the new EC for subsequent elections.
- Accordingly, amendments in the Rule Book (Clause # 10) shall be made as follows:
