Agenda 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of Twelfth EC Meeting held on Oct. 1, 2021 and Action Taken Report

• The minutes of the Twelfth EC Meeting held on Oct. 1, 2021 were confirmed. Thereafter, the ATR report was presented by the General Secretary (*Annexure 2*) along with a brief summary of activities undertaken since the last EC meeting (*Annexure 3*).

Agenda 2: Update on ISPGR Election Result and handing over of documents related to elections

- Dr Celia Chalam V., Election Officer, presented a brief overview of the election process (*Annexure 4*).
- She handed over the results of the ISPGR elections to Dr R.S. Paroda, President, ISPGR for record and necessary action.
- All the EC members placed on record their appreciation for the excellent efforts of election committee (Drs Celia Chalam V., Kavita Gupta and Bharat H. Gawade) in smooth conduct of elections 2021. After this, the election committee members were presented with a certificate of appreciation by the President.

Agenda 4: Handing over of charge by old to new EC members

Agenda 5: Remarks by Director, ICAR-NBPGR

- Further, he suggested that the new EC may give greater responsibility to the Councillors to carry out events such as Brainstorming Sessions, Workshops, Conferences etc. at the zonal level.

Agenda 6: Remarks by Vice President (2019-21), ISPGR

• Dr Kuldeep Singh, Genebank Consultant, ICRISAT, Hyderabad, expressed his satisfaction on the election of the new EC members and conveyed his full support in taking forward all the proposed activities of the Society.

Agenda 6: Remarks by Vice Presidents (2022-24), ISPGR

- Dr J.C. Rana, Regional Coordinator, Alliance for Bioversity International & CIAT, expressed his pleasure for getting the opportunity to serve the PGR community through the new EC of ISPGR. He assured his full support for all the activities of the Society.
- Dr R.K. Tyagi, Coordinator, APCoAB, APAARI, recounted his along association with ISPGR and thanked all the members for once again reposing confidence in him by electing him in the new EC. He shared some of his vision for ISPGR in the next phase, especially regarding the improvement of IJPGR through clear cut terms of reference for both Editorial team and Reviewers.

Agenda 7: Remarks by President, ISPGR

- Dr R.S. Paroda, Chairman, TAAS, thanked the outgoing EC members for their immense contribution and support for the various activities of ISPGR, besides the generous words of appreciation bestowed on him. He congratulated and welcomed the new EC members. He also expressed appreciation for the Election Committee for their professional approach in smooth conduct of ISPGR elections (2021).

 proposed that an event like IAC be organized also at the national level.
- He suggested that Editor-in-Chief and his editorial team develop better strategies to improve the standard of IJPGR.
- He urged that further mobilization of funds be explored to increase the overall financial resources of ISPGR.
- The first meeting of the new EC (2022-24) to be convened at the earliest for early action on all the above matters.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair and all EC members by the Dr Anuradha Agrawal, General Secretary.

Summary Report by Election Committee (2021)

(Dr V Celia Chalam, Dr Kavita Gupta, Dr Bharat H Gawade)

- The Election Committee nominated by ISPGR EC to conduct the 2021 elections of ISPGR EC (2022-24) during September December.
- Election schedule prepared as per Rules and Guidelines and elections for 16 posts of EC were announced on October 7, 2021.
- Total nominations received = 24
 - 2 found invalid, 2 were withdrawn
- Candidates for the posts of President, Treasurer and Councillor (CZ) elected unopposed.
- No nominations received for 3 posts
 - 2 Councillor WZ and 1 Councillor CZ).
- For remaining 10 posts
 - elections held during November 12 -December 15, 2021, in a hybrid mode.
- Ballots were counted on December 18, 2021 and results announced the same day (see Annexure 4, 5).
- The committee thanked the ISPGR President and EC for reposing faith in them to conduct the ISPGR elections, and the ISPGR Secretariat (especially Mr Sunil Bhardwaj and Mr Arup Das under the supervision of Dr Anuradha Agrawal, GS) for their immense support.
