Agenda 1: Welcome remarks

 Dr Anuradha Agrawal, General Secretary (GS), extended formal welcome everyone to the meeting to the new and outgoing members of the Executive Council (EC), as well as The Chairman and Members of the Election Committee. She informed that Director, NBPGR, Drs J.C. Rana, Kuldeep Tripathi, Rose Mary Francies, V.K. Verma, Mohan Lal, S. Tewari, S.K. Bera, Kartar Singh, Pawan Kumar Malav had expressed their inability to attend the meeting due to prior commitments. She informed that the meeting's agenda included the taking over of charge from the outgoing to the new EC and the discussion of planned events for the year 2025 (*Annexure 1*).

Agenda 2: Chairmans' Remarks

- Dr R.S. Paroda, President, ISPGR extended a warm welcome to all the new EC members, including Dr R.C. Agrawal, DDG (Agriculture Education), ICAR, as the new Vice President. He also thanked the outgoing EC members for their valuable contributions. Dr Anuradha Agrawal, was also thanked for her dedicated service as General Secretary. He also thanked Dr R.K. Tyagi for his contributions as Vice-President as well as Editor-in-Chief, IJPGR.
- Further, Dr Paroda thanked Dr Dinesh Kumar and the election committee members Dr Pratibha Brahmi and Dr S. Gopala Krishnan, for conducting the elections in a transparent manner.
- Dr Paroda expressed his personal satisfaction on the progress made by ISPGR in the past three years, particularly in promoting agro-biodiversity and genetic resources management. He highlighted the success of the International Congress on Agrobiodiversity, which has now become a rolling event
- Dr Paroda also highlighted the need for continuous updating of the Societies online database of members and the potential for increased visibility and impact through important events and international collaboration. He encouraged the new EC members to build on the successes of the past and to think creatively about how to make a difference.
- He also mentioned about the upcoming 3rd International Congress on Agrobiodiversity in China (April 22-25, 2025) and desired to widely circulate relevant information to the members. He also suggested that we may consider supporting some senior scientists to participate in the event if their papers are accepted for oral presentation.
- President ISPGR informed that Dr R.K. Tyagi will continue as the Editor-in-Chief
 of the society's journal, with Dr. Sherry Rachel Jacob possibly assisting him as an
 associate editor. Action for hiring of an editorial assistant may also be initiated.
 Improving the journal's impact factor and fostering collaborations with other
 societies will be desirable.
- Thereafter, all the newly elected EC zonal members (Drs Sahi, Amit Kumar, Somnath Roy, and Rohini) introduced themselves and expressed their willingness to serve the society. The outgoing members (Drs Anil Patidar, Monica Singh, and Surendra Barpete) shared their experiences and expressed willingness to effectively contribute to the society's programs in the future.

Agenda 3: Update on ISPGR Election Result and handing over of documents related to elections

- Dr Dinesh Kumar, Election Officer, presented a brief overview of the election process and handed over the results of the ISPGR elections to Dr R.S. Paroda, President, ISPGR for record purpose (*Annexure 4*).
- All the EC members placed on record their appreciation for the efforts of election committee (Dr Dinesh Kumar, Election Officer; Dr Pratibha Brahmi and Dr S. Gopala Krishnan, Members) in smooth conduct of elections 2024. After this, the election committee members were presented with a memento and certificate of appreciation by the President.

Agenda 4: Ratification of ISPGR Election Results by EC

• The EC unanimously ratified the election results.

Agenda 5: Handing over of charge by outgoing to new EC members

• Charge was handed over by outgoing to new EC members. All outgoing EC members expressed their satisfaction on the functioning of the Society under the leadership of Dr R.S. Paroda. New incumbents of EC assured their full support for the activities of society.

Agenda 6: Report by GS on planned events for 2025

 Dr Anuradha Agrawal informed that ISPGR would be co-organizing the 'National Symposium on Hybrid Technology for Enhancing Crop Productivity', scheduled for January 8-10 in New Delhi at NASC, New Delhi. An amount of Rs 3.00 lakhs would be provided to the organizers (TAAS, New Delhi), as already approved earlier by the EC. She encouraged participation, especially for the inaugural session and special evening lectures.

(Action: General Secretary and Treasurer)

• The 3rd International Agro Biodiversity Congress, set for April 22-25 in Kunming, China, was discussed and the possibility of participation by some senior EC/ISPGR staff was considered. If agreed by organizers, ISPGR may hold a side event, in possible collaboration with the Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Rights Authority (PPVFRA), Govt of India, on 'Role of farmer conservers and gene saviors for sustainable conservation and use of agrobiodiversity'. The event would be in a form of a panel discussion with representatives from farming community, genebank representatives, industry and policy makers. As an outcome, it is expected that a roadmap be developed to recognize, support, and integrate the efforts of grassroot farmers into national and global conservation frameworks.

(Action: President and General Secretary)

• Further, it was proposed that a National Symposium be organized in Southern India either in November of this year or February of next year, in consultation with Institute Directors in Hyderabad and Bangalore.

(Action: General Secretary, Councillors South Zone)

• Dr Somnath Roy suggested that a meeting may be held in Hazaribagh in October or November. Dr Sahi also proposed a workshop or meeting in Prayagraj. President asked them to submit concept notes at the earliest.

(Dr Somnath Roy and Dr V.P. Sahi)

• It was decided that the ISPGR awards for 2024 may be announced after incorporating minor changes suggested in the guidelines by the previuos the last award committee.
